# **IV. ENTRIES**

# 4.1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

Closing date for entries: 02/05/2022 (Monday) at 17:00. Closing date for entries with increased fee: 05/05/2022 (Thursday) at 17:00.

## **4.2. ENTRY PROCEDURE:**

Competitors must complete electronic entry form on <u>www.raceonline.lt.</u> Entry form must reach the Organiser until terms specified in Art. 4.1. of These Regulations. Entries are only accepted if accompanied

by the total amount of entry fee. Fully filled and signed entry form must be provided to the Organiser during Administrative Checks. Co-driver details may be specified during Administrative Checking.

Note: in order to speed up procedures and avoid people concentration at Administrative checking Competitors are asked to send scanned photographed documents - Driver and Co-driver competition licenses; Driver and Co-driver valid driving licenses; Medical certificate of aptitude – via e-mail: registracija@gravelfestrally.lt

#### 4.3. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES:

**4.3.1.** Maximum number. Total maximum number of entries - **120**. The priority of entry will be reserved to participants of LARSC and LMRC, who will pay the entry fee on time.

#### 4.3.2. Cars eligible to enter the event

**4.4.1.** The entry fee for the winners of the 2021 LMRC all classes participating in the LARSC event may not exceed 150 EUR. The winners are the first and second drivers who have taken the first place in the LMRC standings. In case if those driver and co-driver are starting in 2022 LARSC being a part of separate crews, the smaller entry fee applies towards both crews.

**4.4.2.** "0" crews accepted in the rally, must pay a 150 EUR deposit. The mentioned deposit is returned in that case, if the crew has performed a qualitative run during all the rally and has fulfilled the tasks and functions trusted to the crew.

#### 4.6. REFUNDS:

Entry fee will be refunded:

- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted - 100%;

- In case of the rally not taking place - 100 %;

- In case of the rally not taking place due to "Force Majeure" - 50 %;

- Candidates cannot participate due to "Force Majeure" acknowledged by ASN - 50 %.

# V. INSURANCE

**5.1.1. Organizer's Liability Insurance.** Organiser insures participants with insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition from start up to the finish or the moment when competitor withdraws or is disqualified from the event.

**5.1.2. Damage Caused to the Third Party.** A part of insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.

#### 5.2. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS:

**5.2.1.** All 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative checking. By the fact of signing entry form, competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN and Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers. Drivers (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>) from non-EU countries have to have valid travel insurance contracts with active recreational risks included.

**5.2.2. Civil insurance.** All crews at Administrative Check have to hand in a valid motor third party liability insurance policy or International Green card for their car. Without these cards, the crew will not be permitted to start.

#### **5.3. DAMAGE REPORTING**

Crews are obliged to notify Organiser about any damage caused on track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty will be penalized by 100 EUR.

#### **5.4. INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS**

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special stickers issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

#### 5.5. DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

The Organiser refuses any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unfair action – either regarding rally regulations or these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident neither a service car, reconnaissance car nor official's car with rally markings are considered as crew of the competition. In these cases, only a car owner third-person liability insurance policies are valid.

# VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

#### 6.1. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Prior to the pre-start scrutineering starting numbers, rally plates and Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

#### 6.2. LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING

Non-compliance with any rules regarding start numbers and advertising will be reported to the Stewards.

# VII. TYRES

#### 7.1. NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES:

7.1.1. LARSC tyres used during I event must comply with "T-2022" Art. 13.1

7.1.2. LMRC tyres used during I event must comply with LMRC 2022 Regulation Art. 4.2.

#### 7.2. TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Only large-scale production tires that comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Regulations may be used. The tires must bear markings in accordance with the EU standard (the "E" symbol with the country of homologation code, eg. E2, E4, etc.). Retreated tyres are forbidden for reconnaissance. Any treatment (ie. removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is not allowed.

### VIII. FUEL

#### **8.1. FUEL RESTRICTIONS:**

E85 fuel (bioethanol), which is commercially available at retail dealers, is permitted.

**8.2.1. All Competitors may only refuel in a Refueling Zone (RZ).** There will be a Refueling Zone after the exit from the Service Park and Remote Refuelling Zone marked in the Road Book if any is foreseen.

**8.2.2. Refueling procedure.** Competitors' cars may be refueled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew. Only crew members and support personnel are responsible for compliance with fire safety regulations during the refueling. Liquid proof mat has to be used. Penalty for non-compliance is 50 EUR.

# IX. RECONNAISSANCE

#### 9.1. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION:

Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows: **13/05/2022 (Friday): 13:00 – 15:00 –** only for competitors participating in LARSC;

**17:00 – 20:00** – only for competitors participating in LMRC.

14/05/2022 (Saturday): 7:00 – 8:00 – only for competitors participating in LMRC.

**9.1.2.** Checking of Reconnaissance cars. Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T2021. If, for any reason, a crew is forced to replace the reconnaissance car during the reconnaissance, the Secretariat (phone: +370-686-85146) must be informed about the details of the new reconnaissance car.

#### **9.2. NATIONAL SPEED LIMITS**

9.2.1 Town/Village 50 km/h Non residence: Gravel roads: 70 km/h Asphalt roads: 90 km/h Motorways: 120 km/h Highways: 130 km/h **9.2.2. Speed during reconnaissance.** All reconnaissance of Special Stages has to be done at reasonable speed in accordance with Lithuanian traffic rules. The maximum speed set for reconnaissance of SS is 80 km/h, except for those areas in which there are speed limit signs or other limitations marked in the Road Book. Breaking the rules and exceeding speed limits on public roads will be also controlled and fined by the Lithuanian Police according to traffic laws of Lithuania.

#### 9.4. RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE:

Reconnaissance time schedule is given in Appendix 2.

#### 9.5. RECONNAISSANCE RULES:

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of T-2022 and these Regulations.

**9.5.1** After publication of Supplementary Regulations, any driver, or co-driver, or any other team member who has entered or intends to enter the rally "Gravel Fest Rally 2022" and who wishes to drive on any road which is or might be used as a Special Stage in the rally (Appendix 5), may only do so after he has obtained the written permission from the Organiser. This shall not apply when the person is known to live along the specific road. Failure to respect this rule shall result in driver being reported to the Stewards and national ASN.

**9.5.2. Number of persons on board.** During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons are permitted in the car. 3<sup>rd</sup> person may drive in the car during reconnaissance only with the permit from the Clerk of the Course and has to have a valid annual driver's license issued by LASF or other ASN.

**9.5.3.** Number of passages. A maximum 2 passages over each Special Stages are permitted during reconnaissance. Special Stages run twice are considered to be one Special Stage.

9.5.4. Speeding. Speeding will be penalized according Art.20.2 of T-2022.

# X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

#### 10.1. SHEDULE

13/05/2022 (Friday): 13:00 - 15:00 - only for competitors participating in LARSC;

17:00 – 20:00 – only for competitors participating in LMRC.

14/05/2022 (Saturday): 7:00 – 8:00 – only for competitors participating in LMRC.

Place: Lazdijai District Municipality Public Library, Seinu str. 1, Lazdijai. 54.2337, 23.5164

The crew must arrive in person for the administrative check according to the schedule published on <u>www.raceonline.lt</u>

Any delay will be penalized with a fine.

#### **10.2 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED**

At Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

Driver and Co-driver competition licences;

Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences;

ASN authorisation (where applicable);

Fully completed entry form;

Medical certificate of aptitude (F 068/a or "Medical certificate of aptitude" FIA ISC, appendix L, cause 1.8);

Valid travel insurance for non-EU drivers;

Note: For crews who submit the required documents electronically, the documents will not be checked. The crew must sign the original, fully completed Entry submitted.

# XI. SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

#### **11.1 SHEDULE**

Pre-start scrutineering will be held in Car service "Vidridas", Turistu str. 37, Lazdijai, 54.2188, 23.5062 **13/05/2022 (Friday): 17:00 – 21:00** – for competitors participating in LARSC and LMRC;

14/05/2022 (Saturday): 8:00 – 11:00 - only for competitors participating in LMRC.

The team or its representative must come to the scrutineering and present the car for inspection according to the schedule published on <u>www.raceonline.lt.</u> Any delay will be penalized with a fine.

### **11.2 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED DURING SCRUTINEERING:**

The following documents must be submitted during Scrutineering:

Valid vehicle insurance policy ("Green card");

Vehicle registration documents; Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable; Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it's applicable; Fully and correctly filled Safety Equipment declaration (only for competitors participating in LARSC).

### 11.3. MUDGUARDS

Transversal mudguards are not mandatory.

### 11.4. WINDOWS

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized on side windows and rear windows only (in conformity with Appendix J Article 253-11).

### **11.5. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

During scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

#### **11.6. NOISE LEVEL**

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for an engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm.

# XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

#### **12.1 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY**

Eastern European Summer Time (CET +2, UTC + 3) is considered official throughout the Rally.

#### **12.2 PRE-START AREA**

Sports cars of LARSC classification crews must be parked in the pre-start area on 14/05/2022 until 8:00 p.m.

Sports cars of LMRC classification crews must be parked in the pre-start area on 14/05/2020 until 12:00 p.m.

#### **12.3 START PROCEDURE**

The sports part of the rally starts at TCO (LARSC standings), TC4D (LARSC standings). All crews start from the pre-start area according to the announced Start list.

#### **12.4 FINISH PROCEDURE**

TC 10A is considered to be the finish of Rally. After the mark, the crews drive through the rally Finish arch to the Parc Ferme in Lazdijai city park, Sodų str. 1A, Lazdijai. The cars will be delivered after the finish podium for scrutineering after the finish of Rally.

Cars can be taken from Parc Ferme only with the permission of Stewards. If the competition does not deviate from the planned schedule, the Parc Ferme will open at 20:55.

#### **12.5 START PROCEDURE FOR SPECIAL STAGES**

- On the start position crew stops when instructed by marshals;
- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position 50 cm before electronically controlled start line the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor.
- 30 seconds before start marshal hands the Time Card to Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up "FALSE" will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2021 Art.48.6.
- The start marshal makes the final decision about false-start and notes this in the start report.
- In case of start system malfunction the start will be given by marshals according to T-2022 Art.48.3.

### **12.6. PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN**

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:

- TC 4C (entering I regrouping);
- TC 7C (entering II regrouping);
- TC 10A (entering PF).

#### 12.9. RE-START / RALLY 2

LARSC standings crews after the rally section I (TC 4D) can be re-started after the withdrawal (Rally 2), after the completion of 2022. Art. 7.6 requirements.

#### **12.10. RETIRING BECAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT**

Retiring Competitors of LARC after an accident must submit their cars to the Chief Scrutineer Saulius Stanaitis, tel. +370 687 31023 for inspection of damage. Failure to do so will result in fines.

#### **12.11. SERVICE ZONE**

**12.11.1. Service zone** will be installed in the square next to the Car service "Vidridas", Turistu str. 37, Lazdijai, 54.2188, 23.5062 Surface: asphalt. Time: from 13/05/2022 16:30 pm to 14/05/2022 21:30 pm. There will be no remote service zone during the competition.

**12.11.2.** Service Areas are allocated by the Organiser, in compliance with the information in entry form. Following Service Areas will be reserved for all competitors free of charge up to 50<sup>m2</sup>. In case the entrant has several competing cars, which are serviced together in the Service Zone, the request for joining Service Areas has to reach the Organiser before 05/05/2022 (Thursday) 17:00 pm.

**12.11.3.** In Service Park, all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Teams must bring weights for fixing their tents. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

**12.11.4.** Only one service vehicle without trailer per one competitor is allowed in Service Park. Vehicles must be clearly identified by a "Service" sticker issued by the Organiser and affixed on the windscreen. Recce and team representative vehicles are not allowed to enter Service Parks.

**12.11.6.** Crews will be fined for non-compliance with the service rules.

#### 12.10. CHICANES

Chicanes will be set on Special Stages for safety reasons, in order to reduce maximum speed. Where it is possible chicanes will be set before reconnaissance and will stay unhindered during whole rally. In places, where such action is impossible, the place of the chicane will be marked on the road surface. Marshals of

the fact will observe the correct passage through the chicane. The list of judges will be posted on the Official Notice Board. Incorrect passage through the chicane will result in 20 seconds penalty.
