4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE

4.2.1 It is the competitor's responsibility to submit the entry form with all attachments. Applications from competitors from outside Poland will be accepted via a dedicated form available on the rally website www.rajdpodlaski.pl, without the need to register on the Inside PZM website. When completing the application, you should also complete the driver's and pilot's personal safety equipment card, which should be submitted to the Scrutineering checklist. After completing the application form and attach the confirmation of the entry fee payment, after approval, it will be automatically sent by e-mail to the organizer and to the competitor, to the e-mail address provided by him in the form.

The electronic entry form allows entering for manufacturers, sponsors.

4.2.2 Competitors must send to biurorajdu@ap.bialystok.pl the following documents:

- payment confirmation of the entry fee (to ensure that payment is duly receipted prior to the close of entries)
- photocopies of the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver Competition licenses,
- photocopies of the Driver and Co-Driver driving licenses,
- photocopy of ASN authorisation for all foreign competitors and/or drivers,
- photocopy of vehicle registration papers,

- photocopy of vehicle insurance cover certificate,

In case one of the above listed obligations is not fulfilled, the Organiser can reject the entry.

4.2.3 An entry application will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fee confirmation.

4.2.4 During a filling out the electronic entry form the following attachments will be available:

- order form of additional space in the Service Park (optional),
- request for adjacent space in the Service Park (optional).

4.2.5 During the Administrative Checks, the competitor is obliged to provide the original application with the signatures of the competitor / driver (s) / co-driver and must be prepared to present the originals of all required documents :

- Photocopies of the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver Competition licenses,
- Photocopies of the Driver and Co-Driver driving licenses,
- Photocopy of vehicle registration papers,
- Photocopy of vehicle insurance cover certificate,

4.2.6 The competitor who wishes to receive a VAT invoice for the entry fee, fee for additional space in the Service Park or other fees must attach to the entry form a billing details. In addition, the message accompanying the transfer must include the tax number for the invoice. If it is not available, it will not be possible to issue an invoice at a later date. Only after meeting this condition competitor will receive VAT invoice during Administrative Checks.

4.2.7 After closing date for entries the electronic entry form will not be available. Edition of crew members and the vehicle, according to Art. 22.2 and Art. 22.4 of FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations will be possible by sending this information to the e-mail address: biurorajdu@ap.bialystok.pl.

4.2.8 By sending the Entry Form the competitor, driver and co-driver agree for processing their personal data for the purpose of the organization of the rally and publishing photos and results in media and on the websites: www.pzm.pl and www.rajdpodlaski.pl. Competitor/driver/co-driver have the right to access, rectify abovementioned and request to stop processing their personal data. Requesting to stop processing personal data means that competitor resigns to participate in the 41 Rajd Podlaski.

Cars with homologation as Kit Cars and the engine capacity between 1400cc and 1600cc, are allowed to participate in Rally (Class HR4), if they also comply with the Art. 255.6.2 „Weight” of 2019 FIA ISC Appendix J. 2-wheel drive cars (2WD) equipped with the supercharged diesel engine with a nominal capacity less than 2000cc (group A and/or N) will be classified in Class HR3.

The competitors taking part in the LARC Championship will additionally have a separate classification according to the provisions of the LARC Regulations.

4.4 ENTRY FEES

4.4.1 In the rally are two deadlines for entry fee payment:

- 1st term – from the opening date for entries (26 April 2022) till 6 May 2022
- 2nd term – apply for last 3 days of entries: 7, 8, 9 May 2022

4.4.2 The entry fee in 1st term, for private entrants (entry made by a member of the crew who competes under his/her own name or pseudonym):

The entry fee in 2nd term is 105€ higher compared to any entry fee presented in a table in the Art. 4.4.2 of these Supplementary Regulations. The date of payment realization (not a date of payment order!) stated in the bank transfer will decide for an entry fee.

4.4.3 For legal entrant entry fee is higher by 105€ compared to any entry fee presented in a table in the Art. 4.4.2 of these Supplementary Regulations.

4.4.4 In the case of application to the classification of sponsor teams apply an additional fee of 105€ per crew.

4.4.5 In the case of application for the classification of manufacturer teams apply an additional fee of 105€ per crew.

4.4.6 The entry fee will guarantee for each crew a service area in the service park.

At the request of the competitor, in case of the space availability, the Organiser may provide additional area in the Service Park for extra charge (priority will be given to competitors – legal entrants). An extra charge for additional area in the Service Park amounts to:

- 5€/m2 – for private entrants,
- 6€/m2 – for legal entrants.

4.4.7 At the request of a competitor made on entry form (if possible), the Organiser can sale a package of additional rally documents in accordance with Art. 8.3.3 RSMP 2022 Regulations. Pack's price is 200 PLN.

4.4.8 Each competitor entered into the rally has the right to use the Gravel Crews on the principles contained in art. 9.5 of these supplementary regulations. The intention to use the route reconnaissance car should be indicated in the application form.

4.4.9 Entry fees do not cover liability insurance of competitors against third parties.

4.4.10 A competitor/driver who wants to be classified in both the 1st round of the Lithuanian Rally Championship (LARC) and the 2nd round of the Polish Rally Championship (RSMP) must indicate it in the entry form. At the same time, to take part in both championships, it is enough to pay only one entry fee (higher entry fee LARC or RSMP).

4.4.11 Winners of 2021 year LARSC classifications and Junior class, who have never before participated in LARC classifications, can take a part in 2022 year LARC or LARC event and their entry fee cannot be higher than 250 EUR. Driver and co-driver are considered as winners if they take first place in any of LARSC classification. In case if those driver and co-driver are starting in 2021 year LARC being a part of separate crews, the smaller entry fee applies towards both crews. (2022 LARC Regulations 8.4.).

Please ensure that the driver's name and a wording "41 Rajd Podlaski Entry Fee" are given as a reference on the bank transfer document.

4.6 REFUNDS

4.6.1 Entry fees will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted and in the case of the rally not taking place.

4.6.2 The Organiser may refund up to 50% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reason of "force majeure" (duly certified in writing by their club / ASN) were unable to start the rally. The application for a refund, stating the reason for not starting, must reach the Organiser in writing **before the start of the Administrative Checks**.

5. INSURANCE

5.1 Every competitor and driver and/or co-driver takes part in the rally at their own risk. The driver must possess a document confirming Third Party Insurance of the owner of the vehicle registered in Poland or in another country, which has been concluded in accordance with law. The Organiser does not take responsibility for any competitor's loss and damage during the rally.

5.2 By the very fact of signing the entry form, the competitor and driver and/or co-driver relinquishes any rights to compensation of any kind which might occur by reason of incidents during the rally. The relinquishment applies to FIA, PZM, the Organiser, Officials and other competitors and drivers and/or co-drivers participating in the rally. Any damages caused by the competitor will be covered from his Third Party Insurance.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Advertising must comply with Polish law.

6.2 The Organiser's mandatory advertising will be placed on competition numbers and rally plates. Those must be affixed to the car in proper places according to Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations and must be visible for the duration of the rally. The mandatory advertising will be communicated by Bulletin.

6.3 The Organiser prepares optional advertising on cars, according to placing and size details as specified in Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations in accordance with Art. 8.3, 8.3.1, 8.3.2 RSMP 2022 Regulations. The optional advertising will be published by the bulletin on the Digital Notice Board on the rally website – www.rajdpodlaski.pl on Friday, 6 May 2022.

6.4 Proper placement of competition numbers, rally plates and the Organiser's optional advertising on the car will be checked before start to the Shakedown stage – for cars taking part in Shakedown and before TC 0 zone – for the others. The lack of optional advertising as described according to Art. 6.3 or its incorrect placement (not complied with Appendix 4) will be treated as an entry without the optional advertising. Increased entry fee, according to Art. 4.4.2. of these Supplementary Regulations will be required.

6.5 The Organiser have the exclusive rights to run every kind of promotional, advertising and commercial activities in the Rally Office, Start and Finish areas, Scrutineering places, Service Park, Parc Fermé and along the entire route of the rally. Each company interested in running any promotional, advertising or commercial activities at the rally should contact with the Organiser with suitable advance and sign the agreement.

6.6 START-FINISH

During Ceremonial Start and Finish of the rally, the crews (driver and co-driver) are not allowed to be accompanied at the podium by members of their team or any other people. Displaying advertising elements such as flags, banners, umbrellas etc., as well as distributing advertising materials is forbidden.

6.7 Service Park

Advertising in the Service Park is permitted in accordance with the Art. 13.10 RSMP 2022 Regulations. Placing advertising outside area allocated according to Art. 4.4.6 of these Supplementary Regulations, is accepted only after receiving a written permission of the Organiser. Failure to comply with these rule (determined by the Service Park Manager) will be penalized with a financial penalty up to 500% of paid entry fee.

6.8 Competition numbers supplied by the Organiser must be affixed on both sides of the car on front doors, rear window and two rear side windows - as shown in Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations, for the entire duration of the rally. In case, that any competition number or rally plate is missing during the rally, this will be reported to the Stewards, who impose a financial penalty. The lack of two competition numbers or rally plates may result in disqualification applied by the Stewards.

7. TYRES

7.1 All tires used by the crew during the rally must comply with art. 14 RSMP 2021 Regulations. The number of tyres for LARC competitors - 10. Tyre count for non LARC competitors is not limited. For LARC competitors tyres must comply with Appendix 13 of 2022 years LARC Regulations (2022 LARC Regulations 4.9.). During the rally, the tyres will be checked and marked in accordance with regulations. Tyres without homologation E must comply with regulations.

7.2 Tyres used during the reconnaissance must have homologation E.

8. FUEL

8.1 All competitors can only use fuel which must be in compliance with Art. 252.9 Appendix J to FIA ISC. LARC participants the use of commercial E85 fuel (bioethanol), sold by retail is allowed. In case if this type of fuel is used, it is mandatory to place "E85" sticker on both back wings of the vehicle. Sticker's example is shown in an Appendix No. 1 (2022 LARC Regulations 4.6.).

8.2 Crews may refuel only in the designated Refuelling Zones and commercial filling stations indicated in the Road Book. Only two team members of each crew may access the refuelling zone during the refuelling. The full responsibility for refuelling is on the competitors' site.

During refueling, all personnel involved in the refueling operation must be dressed in accordance with Art. 61.2.3 of the Sports Regulations. It is recommended that each team, when carrying out the refueling procedure, be equipped with a powder extinguisher with a minimum mass of the extinguishing agent of 2 kg. Additionally, the crew must be outside the car when refueling.

8.3 There will be two remote Refuelling Zones on the route:

- at the Commune Dobrzyniewo Duże square, Białostocka 25 street: N° 53.19842, E°- 23.01996
- company square SaMasz, Trawiasta 1, Zabłudów: N° 53.02992, E°- 23.32439

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 On 20 May 2022 (Friday) from 12:00 till 16:00 in the Rally Office City Stadium in Białystok, Słoneczna 1 street all entered competitors will receive documents necessary for the Reconnaissance: Road Book, Reconnaissance Card, plates for the reconnaissance car.

9.2 Reconnaissance will be carried out on Friday, 20 May 2022 and Saturday, 21 May 2022, according to the schedule specified in Appendix 2 of these Supplementary Regulations.

9.2.1 Reconnaissance SSS3 Białystok will be carried out on Friday, 20 May 2022 and Saturday, 21 May 2022, at any time in compliance with the traffic regulations.

9.3 SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

9.3.1 During Reconnaissance all entered competitors are permitted to make a maximum two passages over each special stage. Only crew can be in the Recce car on each special stage. Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, in accordance with Art. 11 RSMP 2022 Regulations, except in cases described in Road Book(or the Recce Road Book - if such a document will be issued) but they must maintain an extreme caution.

Until Monday, 9 May 2022 the organizer will prepare and make available on the website www.rajdpodlaski.pl video recordings of the route of all Special Sections of the rally.

The Organiser will control the Reconnaissance and adherence to the Polish Traffic Law as well as the other regulations, especially Art. 34.2 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations and this Supplementary Regulations. The crews must show appropriate documents at the request of the Organiser's representatives or Police Officers and must execute their instructions and commands.

The inspections of the special stages will be conducted on regular basis also before the Reconnaissance. Any member of team (competitor, driver and/or co-driver, support personnel) participating or intending to participate in the rally, which will be found present at the any rally SS route before time of Reconnaissance, will be considered a person performing forbidden Reconnaissance (except SSS 3 Białystok).

9.3.2 Rally crews are required to present Reconnaissance Card at the start and stop point of each Special Stage (except SSS 3 Białystok) to obtain time entry.

9.3.3 The Reconnaissance Card must be returned at the stop point of the last Special Stage which will be passed by the crew during Reconnaissance.

9.3.4 Reconnaissance Cars must have the insurance policy according to Polish Traffic Law Act and no liability can be transferred to the organizer.

9.3.5 Reconnaissance may only be carried out with the use of cars in accordance with Art. 35 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations taking into account Art. 11.7 of the RSMP Regulations 2022.

9.3.6 During Reconnaissance competitors must fully respect the Polish Traffic Law regulations, including a use of seatbelts and speed limits:

- 50 km/h in the built-up area (if the sign does not show otherwise),
- 90 km/h outside the built-up area (if the sign does not show otherwise).

Using the radar detectors is forbidden.

9.3.7 Based on Article. 21.10.5 of the Polish Rally Championship Regulations 2022 The Polish Automobile Sport Commission PZM decided to install GPS devices for the monitoring of the route of the rally by all participating teams. The devices will be released during the Administrative Acceptance on Friday, May 20, 2022. The GPS device issuing station will be located at the Rally Office, and the device will be released after paying the fee resulting from its use (PLN 80) and a returnable deposit (PLN 220).

During the reconnaissance of the rally, devices must be installed in the reconnaissance vehicles in accordance with the instructions included in Appendix No. 7 to these Regulations. In the event that the crew needs assistance in this activity, the GPS service will provide them in the Service Park immediately before the start of the reconnaissance of the rally route.

GPS devices will be used to control compliance with the road traffic regulations, with particular emphasis on speed control during the reconnaissance of the rally route, both on special stages and on the approach route. The journey report will be the basis for the possible imposition of penalties in accordance with Art. 9.3 of the Rally Supplementary Regulations.

The fact that the device has been installed and that it is correctly connected to the power supply may be checked at all judges located on special stages during the reconnaissance of the rally. If it is found that the GPS device is not working due to improper installation or the crew's interference in its work, the Stewards will be notified of this fact and may decide to impose a penalty.

GPS devices used during the reconnaissance of the rally route must be returned to the Rally Office on Saturday, May 21, 2022 at 12: 00-15: 00. In the event of damage to the GPS device due to the competitor's fault, he will be obliged to compensate the damage before the first meeting of the Stewards.

9.3.8 Each crew that performs Reconnaissance of the special stage in violation of the rules described in the Art. 9.3 of this Supplementary Regulations will be punished with a penalty as in Art. 10.1.1, Art. 10.1.3, Art. 11.3 and Art. 11.6 RSMP 2022 Regulations (regardless of administrative penalties).

9.4 LOCATION OF SPEED CONTROL SYSTEMS

During Reconnaissance Police patrols will be located on special stages and on the roads between them. They will be equipped with radars for speed control and will cooperate with SS Commanders responsible for Reconnaissance control.

9.5 GRAVEL CREWS

Each competitor entered into the rally has the right to use the so-called Recognition car, in which there may be no more than 2 people representing the competitor. The reconnaissance car, which may be pasted with advertisements of the crew's sponsors, marked with special stickers (in accordance with Annex 5 to these supplementary regulations), with numbers corresponding to the number of the competitor he represents, will be able to enter the

SS route within 80-65 minutes before the start time of the first crew to that SS. The car must move along the SS in accordance with the road traffic regulations, in the direction of the SS. If the car "C" catches up, it must absolutely leave the SS route and cannot return to it. Fracture of the above-mentioned of the rules will result in the consequences drawn by the Stewards towards the represented competitor.

9.5.1 The entry of recognition cars at SS 2 Niewodnica Nargilewska-Kolonia 2, SS 3 Białystok, SS 5 Siekierki 2 will not be possible.

9.5.2 Recognition cars are not allowed to park in the service park. For the above-mentioned cars and tow trucks, the organizer will designate a parking space outside the service park, marked on the service park plan. Failure to comply with the aforementioned requirement and found parking in the service park will result in the imposition of a fine on the competitor in the amount of PLN 300.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 LOCATION

10.2 TIMETABLE

Friday, 20 May 2022 - 12:00 – 16:00

10.3 At Administrative Checks the representative of competitor shall present:

- Duly completed and signed original entry form,
- Valid Competitor's license and Driver's and Co-driver's competition licenses,
- Valid Driver's and Co-driver's driving licenses
- Photocopy of vehicle registration papers,
- Photocopy of vehicle insurance cover certificate,
- Photocopy of vehicle owner authorization, if he is not one of the drivers (except for LARC participants).

10.4 ORGANISER'S DOCUMENTS

After Administrative Checks competitor will receive Administrative Checks Card and Scrutineering Card to present on the Scrutineering. If the car have passed pre-season Scrutineering (applies to competitors entered only to RSMP) the competitor have to present Safety equipment card and sign a declaration that the car he intends to participate in the rally is exactly the same as the car that was presented in pre-season Scrutineering.

In accordance with Art. 8.3.3 RSMP 2022 Regulations, the organizer of the 41 Rajd Podlaski informs that the Supplementary Regulations will be available only in an electronic version.

11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING, MARKING AND INSTALLATION OF RALLY SAFETY GPS TRACKING SYSTEM

11.1 LOCATION

City Stadium – Parking C, Białystok, Słoneczna 1.

11.2 TIMETABLE

Saturday, 21 May 2022, 07:00 – 13:00 – according to the time schedule

Each car should be presented at the Scrutineering by the crew or a representative of the team in their individual time fixed in the schedule that will be published by the bulletin on the Digital Notice Board on the rally website – www.rajdpodlaski.pl on Friday, 13 May 2022.

11.3 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED:

- Scrutineering card.
- driver/co-driver Safety equipment card, (printed and correctly and legibly completed),
- vehicle sporting card - A5 format

- Photocopy of vehicle registration papers,
- vehicle original FIA or ASN homologation form,
- Safety cage ASN certificate (if relevant),
- Catalyst ASN certificate (if relevant).

A valid entry in the registration certificate confirming that the car has passed the technical inspection is deemed to be evidence that the car meets all the requirements of the Road Traffic Law, including safety and environmental protection regulations, and is approved for road traffic in the territory of the Republic of Poland.

Competitors must present during the Scrutineering all items of Safety equipment intended to be used in accordance with Art. 12.1.1 and 12.1.2 RSMP 2022 Regulations.

11.4 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

11.4.1 Any crew reporting late at the Scrutineering (regarding the above mentioned time schedule) will be penalized a fine of 300 PLN.

11.4.2 In well justified and reasonable cases, Organiser can arrange a new Scrutineering time for the crew upon their request (after the time limit fixed in the schedule).

11.4.3 Every crew which wants to use a camera during a rally, this camera must be presented installed in a rally car at the time of Scrutineering. Scrutineers will check if a camera is installed correctly as described in Appendix 6 of RSMP 2022 Regulations.

11.4.4 The use of tinted film on the rear window and side windows of the rally car is allowed according to Art. 253.11 of FIA ISC Appendix J. Tinted film on front door windows has to be admitted by Polish law for use in a road traffic (light permeability of at least 70 percent). The use of silver-plated film is forbidden.

11.5 SCRUTINEERING OF RESTARTING CARS

Scrutineering for cars that failed to complete Leg 1 and want to start to Leg 2 will be held on Sunday, 22 May 2022, at 06:25, in the Parc Fermé - City Stadium – Parking C, entry from Ciołkowskiego street, Białystok. Cars must return to the Parc Fermé until above mentioned time.

12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 CEREMONIAL START

Saturday, 21 May 2022 - 14:30

Białystok – Pl. Jana Pawła II (John Paul II Square). N° 53.13211, E°- 23.16351

Before the rally starts, all crews must report to the pre-start area in accordance with the schedule published on the rally website in the Competitors tab. All competitors taking part in the rally must wear a sports suit and shoes in accordance with the car sport regulations and must be present. Failure to do so will result in a financial penalty of 500 PLN.

12.2 OFFICIAL START OF THE RALLY

Saturday, 21 May 2022 - 15:05 (TC-0)

Białystok - Pl. Jana Pawła II (John Paul II Square).

The official start will take place in accordance with the start list published on the Virtual Notice Board - Rally website - www.rajdpodlaski.pl on May 21, 2022, Saturday, at 14.00.

12.4 STARTING SYSTEM OF SPECIAL STAGES

12.4.1 At the start to each Special Stage there will be located an electronic starting equipment with double-digit display and two green lights. It will be connected with the photocell for detecting a false start. The photocell will be located 50 cm after the start line. An electronic display will be clearly visible to the crew from the start line. The crew arrive in their car at the start line and an electronic display counts down and shows seconds (30" – 15" – 10" – 5" – 4" – 3" – 2" – 1") remaining until the green light turning on (starting signal). The green light will be on for 20 seconds. Within this 20 seconds the crew is obliged to start (according to Art.

12.4.2 At the start of the special stage of SSS 3 Białystok, there will be a signaling device with red and green lights. The green light will come on to mark the start of the special stage. The green light remains on for 5 seconds. During this time, the crew should take off. The crossing of the line determined by the photocell means the start of the timing on the SS route. Entering a special stage while the red light is on will incur a penalty (according to Art. 48.6 of the FIA Sporting Regulations)

12.5 Binding procedures on SSS 3 Białystok

Travel of the planned route of the above-mentioned super special stages will be held in accordance with the Road Book. On the SSS 3 route there are tire posts and a barrel, whose dislocation / overturning will be punishable by a penalty of 5 seconds for each identified incident. The maximum travel time of SSS 3 is 5 minutes. Any crew that fails to complete SSS 3 within this time or pass the above-mentioned SS inconsistently with the planned route will be assigned a time of 5 minutes on this special section. If the car stops on the SSS 3 route, it will be transported by the organizer to the finish line of the special stage immediately after the maximum travel time has elapsed. In this case, the competitor will be deemed to have completed the special stage on time and will be subject to all normal rules, regulations and service restrictions during the rally. SSS 3 is considered not to have been completed by a crew that:

- entered the start zone before SSS 3, but did not start for SSS 3,
- has exceeded the maximum time period referred to in Art. 48.4.3 of the FIA Sporting Regulations.

If it is necessary to suspend the above-mentioned special stage (red flag procedure), the driver is obliged to slow down to a safe speed and follow the instructions of the route security services or other officials. Failure to follow these instructions will result in the imposition of a penalty by the Stewards.

12.6 Crews are authorized to check-in early without time penalty at Parc Fermé –after Leg 1 (TC 3C) and Leg 2 (TC-9C).

12.7 SERVICE PARK

12.7.1 Only one Service Park located in Mikołajki will be organised during the Rally.

Location: City Stadium Białymstok, Słoneczna 1. N° 53.10675, E°- 23.14635

12.7.2 Access

Service Park can be entered only with competition cars, Service cars (SERVICE plates) and Auxiliary vehicles (AUXILIARY plates) with the number of the crew, no sooner than Saturday, 21 May 2022 from 7:00. All cars must be parked inside a service area allocated for a competitor as stipulated in Art. 13.2 RSMP 2022 Regulations.

12.7.3 The competitor is obliged to service only within the allocated service area in the Service Park. These regulations will be controlled by the Service Park Coordinator. Any infringement will result in charging a double fee for additional service area: 40 PLN/m² – for private entrants and 60 PLN/m² – for legal entrants.

12.7.4 During the Administrative Checks, a deposit of € 25 will be charged for leaving an orderly, clean service area after the rally. The deposit will be returned by the manager of the Service Park Coordinator after the position occupied by the crew is accepted without any reservations.

12.7.5 All competitor are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp (size 4x6 m; thickness min. 0,5 mm) on their service area (under serviced cars).

12.7.6 In the Service Park on May 21 and 22, 2022. (Saturday / Sunday) from At 7:00 a.m. there is a driving direction specified in the Plan, an absolute ban on snaking and a speed limit of 30 km / h. Failure to comply with the aforementioned restriction will result in imposing a penalty on the competitor in accordance with art., 10.1.2 of the RSMP 2022 Regulations.

12.7.7 Service stands in the Service Park will not be supervised by the Organizer. The organizer is not responsible for any damage or theft of equipment during the rally. Nevertheless, the Municipal Stadium is a closed facility with video surveillance and 24-hour security.

12.7.8 The organizer does not provide flexi service at the end of Leg 1.

12.8 PZM-GPS SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

12.8.1 PZM-GPS safety tracking system unit will be installed by the PZM-GPS service team during Scrutineering. Before Scrutineering, all cars must have antenna and system console installed according to instruction.

12.8.2 PZM-GPS safety tracking system is used to check if crews drive according to Road Book and it is also an official PZM speed checking device used during the rally. If system indicate a fact of speeding, competitor will be penalized according to Art. 10.1.1 and 10.1.2 of RSMP 2022 regulations.

12.8.3 Any crew without a system installed in a car will not be able to start in rally and/or Shakedown stage. The place and time of assembly / disassembly of GPS devices are specified in Appendix 6 to these Regulations. In case a team withdraws from the Rally, PZM-GPS safety tracking system unit should be returned to the PZM-GPS System Officer (Mr. Bartłomiej Korzeń +48 695 524 900) before a final results publication time. Failure to comply with these rule will be penalized with a financial penalty €105.

12.8.4 Each crew is materially responsible for PZM-GPS safety tracking system installed in their car during Reconnaissance (applies to crews appointed by the Stewards) and during the Rally. In case of damage of this system during the Reconnaissance through the fault of the competitor, he is obligated to compensate the damage before the first Stewards Meeting. In case of damage PZM-GPS safety tracking system during the rally, the competitor is obligated to compensate the damage prior to the last Stewards Meeting. Infringement of this regulations will result in a penalty imposed by the GKSS (Polish Autosport Commission).

12.8.5 In case of damage or PZM-GPS safety tracking system malfunction, device will be replaced at the time set by Organizer. Each replacement of the PZM-GPS device will be reported to the CoC and he will decide to cancel time penalties caused by device replacement.

12.9 SHAKEDOWN

The organizer does not plan shakedown

Immediately after the finish of the rally (TC- 9C) cars appointed by the Steward will be taken to the Final Checks. The crews are obligated to follow the instructions of Organiser. Competitors of cars subjected to the Final Checks must provide one representative and relevant number of mechanics present on the Final Checks.

15.2 PROTEST FEE

The amount of the basic protest fee has been set on: 100 percent of the paid entry fee.

The protest deposit for LARC is €150 (LARC Regulations Art. 10.2). If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit in accordance with LARC Regulations Art. 10.4

However, if the protest requires disassembling and re-assembling of the car or its parts or check the type of fuel used, additional deposit will be specified by the Stewards upon a proposal of the PZM Technical Delegate. If the protest is unfounded, and the expenses incurred by the protest (Scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned. If the protest is upheld all expenses shall be borne by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged.

15.3 APPEAL DEPOSIT

The sum of the National Appeal Fee (to GKSS) against the Stewards decision is €550.

APPENDIX 5 – SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

1. The PZM-GPS safety tracking system unit is installed by the PZM-GPS service team.
2. The PZM-GPS safety tracking system unit is owned by PZM and will be removed after the end of the Rally.
3. You will be given a receipt that will authorize you to collect the documents from the Rally's Office.

Mode of operation PZM-GPS safety tracking system

The PZM-GPS safety tracking system installed in your vehicle during the Rally sends a signal to the Rally Command Centre (RCC). The system is working only on Special Stages and is activated automatically, so it doesn't need any operation before start and after finish the SS.

In case of stopping the car on the SS system is sending the warning signal to the car unit. The lamps in manipulator panel (Green and Red) start blinking. That means that operator of RCC see the car standing on the SS and expect to have the information from the crew. Within 1 minute from stopping over the Special Stage the driver or the pilot should press the proper button to clarify the situation.



PRESSING the GREEN BUTTON means that there is NO NEED to send the emergency service (OK).

To avoid accidental activation, the GREEN button must be depressed for 2 seconds. Correctly pressing the green button will be confirmed by short blink of green lamp in the button and acoustic signal (two short loud beeps). NOT PRESSING the GREEN BUTTON within 1 minute after stop on the SS means the necessity of an assistance and it will initiate the intervention of the emergency service.

In case of emergency, when the crew would need any help from RCC the RED BUTTON should be pressed.

Depressing the RED BUTTON means the emergency and the crew need help for themselves or for somebody else (for example, if they noticed any dangerous situation over the SS).

To avoid accidental activation, the RED button must be depressed for 2 seconds. Correctly pressing the red button will be confirmed by short blink of red lamp in the button and acoustic signal (two short loud beeps)

Within few second after depressing any button, the lamp inside them will light constantly. That means the information from the car is received by RCC and the status of the car is known by the RCC operator.

In case of any needs the operator of Rally Control Centre can send to the Rally crew a reminding signal (series of short beeps) and blinking the YELLOW LAMP. The reminding signal can be cancelled by pressing any proper button on manipulation panel.

APPENDIX 7 - User manual for the GPS device used to monitor the reconnaissance of the rally

Description:

The TC-1 system is designed to monitor the course of the rally. It is mounted in the car indicated by the competitor. The device records and transmits continuously data from the vehicle.

Installation:

The device should be mounted on the inside of the vehicle's lower windscreen, in the center of the vehicle. The assembly consists in sticking the supplied self-adhesive Velcro to the glass and then fixing the device by connecting the glued Velcro with the piece on the device. The device should be visible to the crew.



Power supply of the device:

The device must be connected to the vehicle's cigarette lighter socket.

Power supply presence indication:

The device has a built-in signaling of the presence of supply voltage in the form of a red diode. The red diode lighting means that the device is properly powered. The signaling is equipped with a dimming function - the intensity of the light emitted by the diode will decrease proportionally to the external lighting. There is also an LED in the cigarette lighter plug. It lights when the power is connected. There is no dimming function.

Competitor's Responsibilities:

1. assembling the device on the windshield and connecting the device to the cigarette lighter socket,
2. for the period of reconnaissance, from the time of handing over the device to its return, the cigarette lighter plug must be in the cigarette lighter socket,
3. When the vehicle is in motion or when the vehicle is stationary with the engine on, the power LED on the device and in the cigarette lighter plug must be on. In the event that the light is off, the competitor is required to check the efficiency of the cigarette lighter socket and ensure the availability of voltage. When this is not possible, you should immediately:
 - notify the person responsible for contacts with players,
 - call the number on the label of the device,
4. After the end of the reconnaissance, return the device, undamaged, to the rally office

Device damage:

The following will be considered damage to the device:

- damage to the power connector (cigarette lighter) or connecting cables,
- damage to the device casing that can be noticed and described by means of a photograph and a protocol,
- damage to the electronics of the device that can be noticed and described through photography and protocol.
