The FIA XC Academy Trophy is a new grassroots International Championship sanctioned by the Federation Internationale de L'Automobile (FIA) featuring 75-horsepower off-road vehicles (Cross Cars) designed for young drivers between 13 and 16 years old.

The programme intends to bring to the world of dirt racing a new starting point for aspiring young talents and therefore more opportunities to develop themselves with a clearer path for advancing their careers.

LifeLive was founded in 2016 with the aim of establishing itself in a serious and professional manner in motorsports. LifeLive is headquartered in Belgium right next to the city of St. Vith located close to Germany, Luxemburg and France.

The enterprise is headed by Yannick Neuville who receives the support from his brother Thierry Neuville, 5 times runner-up in the World Rally Championship "WRC" driving for Hyundai Motorsport.

Lately the experienced team of mechanics and engineers has worked to proudly present their first XC Cross Car named "TN5" which has been built according to the newest FIA technical and safety standards. The FIA has created an arrive and drive carbon neutral Cross Car Academy Trophy for 20 participants, all cars strictly identical (except the livery). Each season will be composed of five rounds taking place all across Europe.

Registrations will be managed by the FIA and the sporting format will be identical to the current European Autocross Championship (www.fia.com).

One Cross Car will be allocated to each competitor for the full year, drawn ahead of the season start. In order to guarantee fairness and equality between all competitors, the electronic control unit of each Cross Car will rotate randomly for every round.

All cars will be operated by LifeLive (www.lifelive.be) and the commercial offer will:

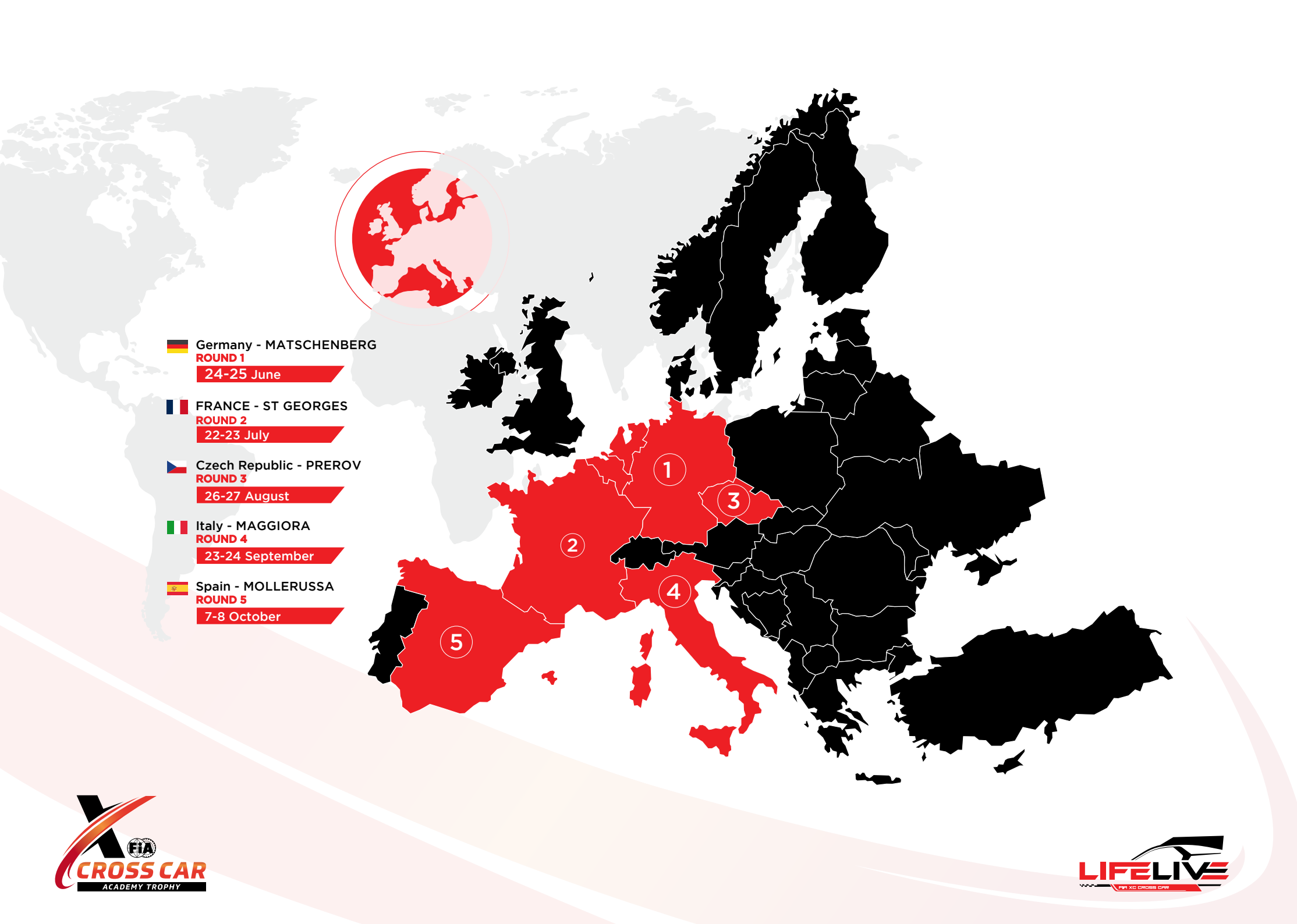

Each competitor is allocated one full set of tires per round, in case of puncture the cost of a tyre is EUR 120,- for front and EUR 130,- for rear.

The cost of a rim* is EUR 99,- for the front and EUR 109,- for the rear.

*Rims are not included in the insurance coverage

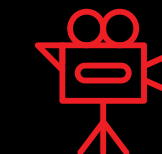
