IV. ENTRIES

4.1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES:

Closing date for entries: 21 July 2023 (Friday) at 18:00.

Closing date for entries with increased fee: 22 July 2023 (Saturday) at 18:00.

4.2. ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Competitors may enter the event using the on-line entry system which can be accessed via www.autorally.lt. Entries are only accepted if accompanied by the total amount of entry fee. Fully filled and signed entry form must be provided to the Organiser during Administrative Checks. Co-driver details may be specified during the Administrative Check.

Note: in order to speed up procedures and avoid people concentration at Administrative checking Competitors are asked to send scanned documents - ASN authorisation (where applicable); Medical certificate of aptitude - via e-mail info@rallyrokiskis.com.

4.3. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES:

4.3.1 Maximum number. The maximum number of entries accepted will be 110. If more than 110 entries are received, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries will be accepted.

4.3.2. Cars eligible to enter the event

For the winners of 2022 Lithuanian Automobile Rally Sprint Championship (LARSC) and 2022 Lithuanian Mini Rally Championship (LMRC), who have not previously participated in the LARC, entry fee is **250 EUR**. The winners are considered 1st and 2nd drivers, who took the first place in the LARSC or LMRC standings. If these the 1st and 2nd drivers start in different crews in 2023 LARC, the reduced entry fee applies to both crews. The reduced start for the Junior standings applies only to the first driver, i.e. his crew.

Crews participating in Lada Cup classification and willing to participate in Historic classification pay fee for both classifications.

For the winners of 2022 Lithuanian Mini Rally Championship (LMRC), who have not previously participated in the LARSC, entry fee is **200 EUR.** The winners are considered 1st and 2nd drivers, who took the first place in the LMRC standings. If these the 1st and 2nd drivers start in different crews in 2023 LARSC, the reduced entry fee applies to both crews. The reduced start for the Junior standings applies only to the first driver, i.e. his crew.

LARC and LARSC team entry fee must be paid no later than 2023-07-28 (Friday) 12:00. Applicants' license or its copy must also be presented.

"0" crews willing to participate in rally, must pay a **250 EUR** deposit (details for bank transfer are provided in 4.5. article) which will be returned only after the discussion of the competition in the Rally Committee and confirmation that the "0" crew has performed its functions properly.

- Candidates cannot participate due to "Force Majeure" acknowledged by ASN 50 %;

V. INSURANCE

5.1. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANISER:

5.1.1. Organiser's Liability Insurance

Organiser has concluded an insurance contract with Organiser's liability insurance covering damage caused to a third party during the competition up to 58000 EUR.

5.1.2. Damage Caused to the Third Party

A part of insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.

5.1.3. International Green Card

All crews at Administrative Check have to hand in a valid motor third party liability insurance policy or International Green card for their car. Without these cards, the crew will not be permitted to start.

5.2. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS:

All drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative checking.

By the fact of signing entry form, competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN and Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers. Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries have to have valid travel insurance contracts with active recreational risks included.

5.3. DAMAGE REPORTING:

Crews are obliged to notify Organiser about any damage caused on track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty will be penalized by 100 EUR.

5.4. INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS:

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special stickers issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured Organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.5. DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS:

The Organiser refuses any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unfair action — either regarding rally regulations or these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident neither a service car, reconnaissance car nor official's car with rally markings are considered as crew of the competition. In these cases, only a car owner third-person liability insurance policies are valid.

VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING:

Prior to the pre-start scrutineering starting numbers, rally plates and Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

6.2. LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING:

Failure to comply with any regulations concerning the plates and identification numbers will be sanctioned as follows:

- One missing Rally Plate or Competition Number: cash penalty of 100 EUR;
- Competition Numbers or Rally Plates are missing at the same time: reported to the Stewards;
- Rally Plates failing to be visible or partially covering license plate: cash penalty of 100 EUR;

VII. TYRES

7.1. NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES:

- **7.1.1. Number of tyres.** The number of tyres for the LARC competition is 12. For other competitors number of tyres is unlimited. Tyres used during the shakedown and city stage (SS17) will not be counted towards the maximum number of tyres used during event.
- **7.1.2. Eligible tyres.** Only gravel sports tires may be used during the rally. For LARC competitors tyres must comply with Appendix 14 of 2023 LARC Regulations.

7.2. TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE:

Only E- or DOT-approved road homologated tyres are allowed. Retreated tyres are forbidden for reconnaissance. Any treatment (ie. Removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is not allowed.

VIII. FUEL

8.1. FUEL RESTRICTIONS:

E85 fuel (bioethanol), which is commercially available at retail dealers, is permitted.

8.2. REFUELLING:

- **8.2.1.** All Competitors may only refuel in a Refuelling Zone (RZ) and Remote Refuelling Zone (RRZ). There will be a Refuelling Zone marked in the Road Book after the exit TC from the Regrouping area in Rokiškis, Remote Refuelling Zone Remote Refuelling Zone in Obeliai during section 6 and section 8 of the rally.
- **8.2.2.** Refuelling at the exit of the Service Park and at RRZ. Competitors' cars may be refueled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew.
- **8.2.3. Refuelling procedure.** Only crew members and support personnel are responsible for compliance with fire safety regulations during the refueling. Liquid proof mat has to be used. Refueling is carried out in accordance with T-2023 Art.61.2. Non-compliance with rules will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

IX. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION:

Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows:

27 July 2023 (Thursday) 8:00-12:00 (LARC) and 17:00-21:00 (only LARSC entries participating in Shakedown);

28 July 2023 (Friday) 7:00-9:00 (LARSC)

9.1.1. Checking of Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T-2023. If, for any reason, a crew is forced to replace the reconnaissance car during the reconnaissance, the Clerk of the Course (phone: +370 614 81141) must be informed about the details of the new reconnaissance car.

9.2.NATIONAL SPEED LIMITS:

9.2.1. Speed during reconnaissance

All reconnaissance of Special Stages has to be done at reasonable speed in accordance with Lithuanian traffic rules. The maximum speed set for reconnaissance of SS is 70 km/h, except for those areas in which there are speed limit signs (50 km/h or 30km/h) or other limitations marked in the Road Book. Breaking the rules and exceeding speed limits on public roads will be also controlled and fined by the Lithuanian Police according to traffic laws of Lithuania. **GPS data will also be monitored during liaison.**

9.3. GPS SPEED CONTROL CHECKING DEVICES:

9.3.1. Collection of GPS speed control checking devices

During Administrative Checks

27 July 2023 (Thursday) 8:00-12:00 (LARC) and 17:00-21:00 (only LARSC entries participating in Shakedown);

28 July 2023 (Friday) 7:00-9:00 (LARSC)

9.3.2. Rally Safety Tracking system

Organiser will provide a rally safety tracking system, which has to be used during reconnaissance in the reconnaissance car. If the system will not be used, it is a breach of the reconnaissance regulations. The progress of reconnaissance will be monitored via GPS system by rally officials. GPS data will be monitored also during liaisons. Evaluation of GPS data is within competence of Clerk of the Course. If reconnaissance vehicle is not equipped with a working tracking device, the crew will be penalized by Stewards. After reconnaissance, crews have to re-install the tracking device to the rally car.

Returning of tracking device for both LARC and LARSC crews after TC 17A to Rally HQ until 29 July 2023 (Saturday) 21:30 at the latest.

9.3.3. Principles of Security and Tracking. Each device has a unique serial number that is assigned to the crew. During the race, the Rally Headquarters tracks the location and speed of each crew. The GPS tracking device is connected to the tracking centre, that collects all incoming data. All data is stored on the same device. The device has an autonomous voltage source operating throughout the rally. The device has SOS and OK buttons. By pressing the SOS button, crew members report about the accident and request immediate assistance. In this case, it is necessary to report the accident via the telephone number indicated on the sticker of the GPS device. When the car stops in the speed stage due to an accident or technical problems, by pressing the OK button, the crew members inform the rally HQ about the car stopping for more than 30 seconds and also announce that emergency assistance is not required. Attention! If the crew has stopped in the speed stage for a period longer than 30 seconds, even if the crew tries to continue the race, it is necessary to send an "OK" message. The crew's mobile phones must be switched on (or switched on within 60 seconds) so that the Rally HQ can inquire about the current situation. If the crew receives an electronic red flag alarm (an audible signal and the yellow light switches), the OK button must be held down for 1 second to acknowledge receipt of the message to the Rally control centre. The crew must immediately reduce speed and follow the marshals' instructions. Failure to comply with these requirements will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

9.4. RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE:

Reconnaissance time schedule is given in Appendix 2.

9.5. RECONNAISSANCE RULES:

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of T-2023 and these Regulations.

9.5.1 Restriction of reconnaissance

Any driver, or co-driver, or any other team member who has entered or intends to enter the rally and who wishes to drive on any road which is or might be used as a Special Stage in the rally after publication of Supplementary Regulations, may only do so after he has obtained the written permission from the Organiser. This shall not apply when the person is known to live along the specific road. Failure to respect this rule shall result in driver being reported to the Stewards.

9.5.2. Number of persons on board

During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons are permitted in the car.

9.5.3. Number of passages

A maximum 2 passages over each Special Stages is permitted during reconnaissance. Special Stages run twice are considered to be one Special Stage. This rule doesn't apply to city stage (SS 17).

9.5.4. Speeding

Exceeding speed during reconnaissance will be penalized in accordance with T-2023 Art. 34.2.2. Exceeding speed during the race will be penalized in accordance with T-2023 Art. 34.3.

If the rally car and/or service cars exceed the speed limit in the Service zone, a fine of EUR 25 will be imposed for each exceeded kilometer per hour (T-2023 Art.57.4).

X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED:

At Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

Competitor's licence;

Driver and Co-driver competition licences;

Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences;

ASN authorisation (where applicable);

Completion of all details on the entry form;

Medical certificate of aptitude (F 068/a or "Medical certificate of aptitude" FIA ISC, appendix L, cause 1.8);

In order to speed up procedures and avoid people concentration competitors are asked to book a time for administrative checking on $\underline{www.autorally.lt}$.

XI. SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

11.1. LOCATION AND SCHEDULE:

2023-07-27 (Thursday) 13:00–21:00 (LARC, only LARSC entries participating in Shakedown);

2023-07-28 (Friday) 7:30-11:00 (LARSC);

Location: Respublikos str.111, Rokiškis. Coordinates: 55.9534, 25.5910.

Participants may request the suitable scrutineering time during on-line registration at www.autorally.lt.However, organiser reserves the sole right to move the scrutineering time in attempt to make scrutineering as efficient as possible. The detailed timetable for pre-rally scrutineering will be published on www.autorally.lt, mobile application "Sportity".

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable to be issued in a Bulletin. **Any lateness entering to pre-rally Scrutineering area will be fined by 30 EUR for each 10 minutes delayed.** Driver and Co-driver are not required to be present during Scrutineering.

Documents to be presented during Scrutineering:

Valid vehicle insurance policy ("Green card");

Vehicle registration documents;

Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable;

Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it's applicable;

Fully and correctly filled printed Safety Equipment declaration (must be fulfilled on www.autorally.lt);

11.2. MUDGUARDS:

Transversal mudguards are not mandatory.

11.3. WINDOWS:

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized on side windows and rear windows only (in conformity with Appendix J Article 253-11)

11.4. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

During scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

11.5. NOISE LEVEL:

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for an engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm.

11.6. INSTALATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM:

- **11.6.1.** All Competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the Safety Tracking System. Systems will be issued at the Administrative Checks. All further details will be given during presentation to each crew.
- **11.6.2.** Competitors must have installed the speed control and safety tracking devices in reconnaissance cars before reconnaissance starts. The system must be re-installed to the rally cars by the crews and must be shown to the Scrutineers in pre start holding area on 28 July 2023 (Friday) (LARC) and 29 July 2023 (Saturday) (LARSC).
- **11.6.3.** Any attempt to tamper with, to manipulate or to interfere with the tracking device fitted to the competition car or any device that fails to record a trace due to external interference will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURE AND ORDER:

Ceremonial rally start will take place on 28 July 2022 (Friday) 14:30 in Nepriklausomybės square, Rokiškis, next to the stage and service park. For LARSC entries rally starts at TC9C 29 July 2023 (Saturday).

All rally cars must be parked in pre-start holding area from 13:05 until 13:55. Pre-start holding area is going to be next to the Service Park marked in Road Book. Before entering the pre-start holding area, all competitors must pass GPS tracking system checks.

12.2. FINISH PROCEDURE:

After the final Special Stage all crews will continue to Park Fermé and from there to the end of rally Podium Finish at Rokiškis Manor House, Tyzenhauzų str. 5, Rokiškis.

The finish for LARC and LARSC will be at TC 17A (entrance to Park Fremé). From there Competitors are invited to the place of the rally Podium Finish at Rokiškis Manor House, Tyzenhauzų str. 5, Rokiškis.

Only class winners' of 1st place cars of LARC and LARSC will be taken to the Podium Finish place from Park Fermé. Competitors or Team representatives of cars which are supposed to go through the Podium must be ready at Park Fermé by **21:15** the latest. Cars will be guided from Park Fermé to the Podium place. There is no Park Fermé after the Podium ceremony.

12.3. PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN:

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:

TC 3A (entering the service);

TC 3B (entering regrouping area);

TC 6A (entering the service);

TC 6B (entering Park Fermé);

TC 12A (entering the service);

TC 12B (entering regrouping area);

TC 17A (entreing Park Fermé);

12.4.START PROCEDURE FOR SPECIAL STAGES:

Start procedure for special Stages will be as follows:

- On the start position crew stops when instructed by marshals;
- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position 50 cm before electronically controlled start line the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor.
- 30 seconds before start marshal hands the Time Card to Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up "FALSE" will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2023 Art.48.6.
- The start marshal makes the final decision about false-start and notes this in the start report.
- In case of start system malfunction the start will be given by marshals according to T-2023 Art.48.3.

During the Rally one regrouping for LARSC crews will be performed according SS 10-12 results. New start time for crews TC 12C.

12.8. RETIRING BECAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT:

Retiring Competitors of LARC after an accident must submit their cars to the Chief Scrutineer Paulius Mileška +370 629 08495 for inspection of damage. Failure to do so will result in fines.

Service regulations will be in accordance with T-2023.

Service Park is located on Respublikos str. in Rokiškis. Surface: tarmac.

Service Park opens on 27 July (Thursday) 8:00 and closes on 29 August 2023 (Saturday) 23:30.

12.9.1. The Service Area of 48m² will be reserved in Service Park for each competition car. If Competitor has multiple competition cars to be located together in Service Park, the information for consecutive Service Areas must be filled in application form according the 4.1 art.

Additional service are will cost 5 Eur / sq. m. Payment must be submitted together with entry fee according art. 4.4.1 and art. 4.4.2. Payment details in art. 4.5. If payment for additional service area will not be done, additional area will not be provided.

12.9.2. In Service Park, all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Teams must bring weights for fixing their tents. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage.

12.9.3. One service vehicle per all competitors is allowed in Service Park. Vehicles must be clearly identified by a "Service" sticker issued by the Organiser and affixed on the windscreen.

Team/VIP plates (stickers) must be affixed to the upper side of the windscreen on the right (passenger) side. Removal of the sticker is prohibited until the end of the rally.

Reconnaissance cars and VIP vehicles are not allowed to enter Service Park.

12.9.4. Competitors who fail to comply with Service Park rules are subject to a penalty starting from 100 EUR up to exclusion.

12.9.5. Trailer parking will be located Respublikos str. 111, Rokiškis.

12.10. CHICANES:

Due to safety reasons, chicanes will be positioned on the rally route to reduce speed of rally cars. For the duration of Reconnaissance, if possible the Chicanes will be positioned on the spots where they will stand also during the rally. On the spots where positioning of chicanes for the duration of Reconnaissance is not possible, the spots will be marked on the road. Judges of Fact will monitor the correct passing of the chicanes. The list of Judges of Fact will be published on the Official Notice Board. Failure to pass the chicanes in a correct manner will be penalised by 20 sec. adding to crew's overall time for SS.

12.11. RALLY2

Re-start after retirement (Rally 2) for LARC crews is possible at TC 6C.

Re-start after retirement (Rally 2) for LARSC crews is possible at TC 12C.

Crews must inform Competitors' Relations Officer immediately on decision to use a Rally2 rule and fill in retirement form in a road book.

12.11. SHAKEDOWN:

28 July 2022 (Friday) 9:00-11:30

Competitors willing to take part in Shakedown SS will have to inform Organiser about it by marking it in the Entry Form. Cars participating in Shakedown have to pass scrutineering before SS and have to have GPS tracking system mounted in the car. There will be maximum **3** passes through Shakedown SS. There is no separate Service Zone for Shakedown SS, all cars must be serviced in the Main Service Zone. Maximum number of crews – **50.** Registration for Shakedown might be stopped after a maximum number of participants is reached.

Fee for Shakedown **150 Eur.** Should be paid together with entry fee according art. 4.4 until deadlines in art. 4.1. Payment details provided in art. 4.5.

Competitors who will be selected for the final Scrutineering (Stewards' decision) will be scrutineered in auto service "Egrena" Taikos str. 18, Rokiškis. In case of a protest, the team of car in question is requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and mechanics at the Final Scrutineering venue. Each selected car will be driven to Final Scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the Parc Fermé immediately after notification), and accompanied by an official.

13.2. PROTEST DEPOSIT FEE:

The protest deposits are €150 (LARC), €100 (LARSC).

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit as specified in LARC (LARSC) Regulation Art. 10.4.

13.3. APPEAL DEPOSIT FEE

The sum for a national appeal deposit (ASN) is: € 1000.
